Introduction

In the framework of the Italian G7 Presidency and the 9th Strategic Dialogue of the Carbon Market Platform (CMP), we are pleased to organise this Roundtable Dialogue on carbon markets, with a focus on growth with integrity, and market & policy trends in international carbon credits around the world.

In April 2024, the G7 Ministers of Climate, Energy and the Environment highlighted countries' commitment to the Principles of High Integrity Carbon Markets, and the need for further exchanges on their implementation. Furthermore, the G7 Ministers committed, in relation to carbon markets, to explore innovative options for enhancing demand and robust certification standards for carbon dioxide removals (CDR).

Bringing together G7, interested G20 and other countries, as well as the private sector and international entities, this special dialogue aims to strengthen international exchange and co-operation in developing effective, sustainable, and ambitious carbon pricing approaches.
